LEADER TRAINING

Scout, Cub and Beaver Leader training courses certified by our association and run by National and regional training teams made up of experienced leaders, all volunteers, are provided. The main courses are:

- Preliminary Training Course (2 days)
- Wood Beads Part 1 (Theory) (corrosp)
- Wood Beads Part 2 (Practical) (4 days)
- Safety In the Hills (4 days)

Most leaders also hold the St. John Ambulance 1st Aid course (2 days).

Three leaders attended the PTC at 'Paddicks Patch' Scout campsite in Reading recently. Phil. West (Beaver Master), Dianne Blanchard (Assistant Beaver Mistress) and Jonathan Walter (Assistant Scout Master) spent their weekend studying the association policies, guidelines and organisation as well as practicing practical skills related to running their respective sections.

OUR GROUP VEHICLES

Currently our group own two minibuses. These are ours, bought and paid for. Not exceptionally pretty but they belong to 1st Blackwater Valley B-P Scout Group. These vehicles are funded solely by **fund raising** so that the costs of travel are not included in the cost of outings, hikes and camps. This makes a huge difference to the activities that our sections can contemplate. It means that the Beaver, Cub and Scout leaders can ask the question "do we want to do this?" rather than "can we do this?"

Just like the Scout Hut, these facilities take time and effort to maintain and there is a vast difference in cost if we can effect maintenance and repairs ourselves rather than pay commercial rates.
